Toronto Youth Job Corps (TYJC) connects you to a paid work placement that can turn into a full-time job.

WHAT YOU GET:

- Improve your professional skills.

- Exclusive hands-on employment and life skills workshops.
- Five weeks of paid employment preparation.
- A paid 16-24 week work placement upon program completion.

TYJC is open to Toronto youth who are not currently employed or on Employment Insurance (EI) and are legally able to work in Canada.
